WITNESSETH, That we, the undersigned,^{*} all _____ of whom are citizens of the State of Ohio, desiring to form a corporation, not for profit, under the general corporation laws of said State, do hereby certify:

FIRST. The name of said corporation shall be Mohawk Golf Club

SECOND. Said corporation is to be located at Tiffin
in Seneca County, Ohio, and its principal business there transacted.

THIRD. Said corporation is formed for the purpose of encouraging and promoting an interest in golf and other athletic sports by providing means and facilities for the recreation, physical culture, amusement and social intercourse of its members and their guests; with the right to undertake, enter into, conduct and carry out contracts of all kinds pertaining thereto; to buy, own, hold, sell, lease and convey or otherwise, such real or personal property as may be incident to, or necessary in carrying out the full purpose thereof; and with the right to purchase, hold, sell, pledge, dispose of, issue, and re-issue, the shares of its capital stock, and any evidence of its indebtedness, and with the further right of doing any and all other things necessary and proper to carry out said purpose, business and enterprise.

Fourth: The capital stock of said corporation shall be twenty five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) consisting of one hundred shares of common stock of the par value of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) each.
