## CERTIFICATE OF AMENDMENT

## TO ARTICLES OF

The Church Of The Body Of The Lord Jesus Christ, Inc.

(Name of Corporation)

Peggy H. Moore, who is Chairman of the Board, and Pastor  
President, Vice President (check one) and Margaret A. Harris,  
who is Secretary, Assistant Secretary (check one) of the above named Ohio  
corporation organized not for profit, does hereby certify that:

at a meeting of the members of said corporation duly called and  
held on the 9th day of October, 19 87, at  
7 o'clock, P. M., at which meeting a quorum of  
such members were present, by the affirmative vote of 100%  
of the members present thereat,

in a writing signed by all the members who would be entitled to  
notice of a meeting or such other proportion not less than a  
majority as the articles or regulations permit,

the following resolution of amendment was adopted: Paragraph VI of the articles  
is to be amended to read: Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be  
distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3)  
of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code,  
or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government,  
for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the  
Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization  
is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations,  
as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such  
purposes.

IN WITNESS WHEREBY, the above named officers acting for and on behalf  
of the corporation have subscribed their names this 2nd day of  
November, 19 87.




