The undersigned, desiring to form a corporation, not for profit, under Section 1702.01 of seq., Revised Code of Ohio, do hereby certify.

FIRST. The name of said corporation shall be: Akron - Urban

Minority Alcoholism Drug Abuse Outreach Program, Inc.

SECOND. The place in Ohio where the principal office of the corporation is to be located is:

762 Mallison Avenue, Akron, Ohio 44307, Summit County (City, Village or township)

THIRD. The purpose or purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

To Provide Alcohol and Drug Education, Prevention, Advocacy and services, which shall include, but are not limited to the following areas:
